# Amendment to Notice of Race - (1)

Issued: 17 January 2018

The following clauses of the Notice of Race are amended as follows:

## 5.2 RACING TIMES:

## **Day One**

Registration: 0800 - 1030 Measurement and Inspection: 0800 - 1030

Briefing commences: 1045 Warning signal for first race: 1100

Racing concludes: No heat will commence after 1800

Welcome barbecue and refreshments at the Clubhouse

### **Subsequent Days:**

Briefing commences: 0945 Warning signal for first race: 1000

Racing concludes: No heat will commence after 1800

#### **Final Day:**

Briefing commences: 0945 Warning signal for first race: 1000

Racing concludes: IOM: No race will commence after 1600

10R, A, RM: No race will commence after 1300

Presentation function: The presentation function (BBQ) will be held immediately after the completion of racing.

#### 9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available on event website and a copy will be placed on the Event Noticeboard prior to the commencement of racing.

#### 13 SCORING

- 13.1 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 13.2 Where there are less than 21 competitors, the event may be sailed in one fleet.
- 13.3 The scoring system is as follows:
  - a) For **single fleet** racing
    - i) The Low Point System (RRS A4) will apply.
    - ii) After 4 races have been completed, 1 discard.
    - iii) After 8 races have been completed, 2 discards.
    - iv) After 16 races have been completed, 3 discards, then adding one extra discard for every further 8 races completed.
  - b) For **multi fleet** racing RRS A4 as amended by HMS and the Event Sailing Instruction shall apply.
- 13.4 Racing will be held during the scheduled times with a maximum of 40 races for the series. There shall be no limit to the number of races/heats sailed on each day.
- 13.5 The warning signal for the next race/heat shall occur as soon as practical following the previous race/heat.
